Christ the Saviour is born."




Reading - Luke 2:8-14

Reading - Luke 2:15-20


Carol – While shepherds watched their flocks by night, all seated on the ground, an angel of the Lord came down, and glory shone around.

"All glory be to God on high, and to the earth be peace; to those on whom his favour rests goodwill shall never cease."




Reading - Matt 2:1-11
